## Ritual Books in Spanish

There are six Spanish-language liturgical books and two liturgical book collections that have been confirmed for liturgical use in the United States. For other rites that do not have a confirmed U. S. Spanish edition—for example the *Leccionario*, rituals for Penance, Ordination, etc.—according to the USCCB, “any Spanish translation lawfully approved by another Conference of Bishops may be used.” Ritual books from Mexico tend to be the most popular in the United States, and many of them are available through Liturgical Press or from the Mexican publishing house Buena Prensa.
