“Upholding Dignity Through Our Ministries”

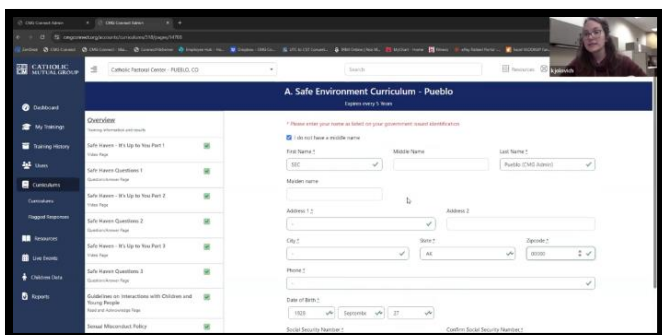

Improving our Background Check Experience

The Diocese of Pueblo's Partnership with Selection.com Background Check Screenings

2025 marked an important change for the Diocese of Pueblo's Safe Environment Program. In October, the diocese partnered with Selection.com as its exclusive background check provider.

Selection.com is a faith-based background screening agency that has been in business for over 30 years, and the exclusive background check partner of CMG Connect. With this partnership, both background screenings and Safe Environment training can be completed at one time through the CMG Connect portal. This has proved incredibly effective in simplifying the implementation of the Safe Environment program, and will continue to support the efficacy of the program into the future.

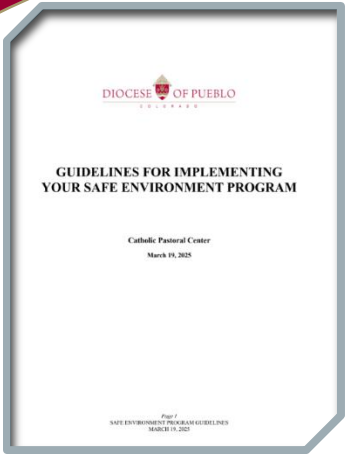

These guidelines were developed from the questions and comments received from partners across the diocese and lays a foundation for the easy implementation of the Safe Environment Program.

The new guidelines have proven to be a valuable resource for the Diocese of Pueblo, and the Safe Environment Office continues to offer support to parishes through the contents of this guide.

Sexual Misconduct Policy Updates

The diocesan Sexual Misconduct Policy was updated in late 2024, which has helped to bring greater clarity to the diocesan Safe Environment Program. Specifically, the revisions of the policy have helped our diocese understand background check and safe environment renewal periods. Together, the Safe Environment Office and all parishes, missions, schools, and entities are working together to implement this policy for the benefit of the faithful.

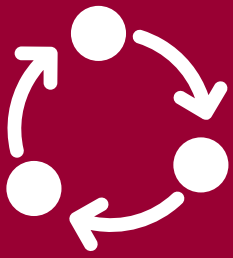

Supporting a Culture of Accountability

Annual USCCB Safe Environment Audit

Each Year, the Diocese of Pueblo completes the Annual USCCB Safe Environment Audit, an important step in creating accountability for the Church through compliance with the *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People*.

In 2025, the Diocese completed an on-site audit visit to verify our protection initiatives.

As it has every year since the inception of the USCCB Safe Environment audit in 2003, the Diocese of Pueblo has passed the 2025 audit and is in compliance with the USCCB's Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People!

Through the designated support of the Safe Environment Office, the diocese is refining processes, making it possible for people to encounter Christ, and piloting programs that enhance the faith.

The culture of accountability created by the development of a safe environment extends beyond simple compliance. Through the creation of effective processes, empowered partners, and safe ministries, a strong foundation for the Church to thrive is being developed.

What is Next for the Safe Environment Office?

Since its creation in 2023, the diocesan Safe Environment Office has experienced success in establishing the protection of the faithful as a core aspect of the ministries of our diocese and delivering administrative support and consultation for our parishes.

In 2026, the office has plans for continued development, resulting in a greater impact for our diocese, and a stronger support base for those who manage and administer the Safe Environment Program. The effect from these efforts will be a more robust diocese, and stronger Church.
