## Welcome to The Most Holy Trinity Church, Trinidad Pilgrimage Site

In consonance with the guidelines for the celebration of The Jubilee Year of Hope 2025, Bishop Stephen Berg has graciously designated our parish Church – Most Holy Trinity Trinidad, as one of the pilgrimage sites for the people of God.

As 'Pilgrims of Hope', we celebrate with the universal Church, a year of Jubilee. According to Vatican decree, local pilgrims of hope may receive plenary indulgence under the normal conditions when they travel to established pilgrimage sites in the spirit of pilgrimage during the jubilee year.

## Jubilee 2025 Q & A

What is a Jubilee Year? The jubilee year is a special year in the life of the Church currently celebrated every 25 or 50 years with roots in the Old Testament (Lev.25:9-10). It is a holy year of the forgiveness of sins, conversion and joyful celebration. Hence, Jubilee years emphasize the sacrament of reconciliation and restoring relationship with God. They call Christians to action and provide opportunities for special Jubilee indulgence.

**2025 Jubilee Year of Hope:** Jubilee 2025 was proclaimed by Pope Francis in the papal Bull, 'Spes Non Confundit' (*Hope does not disappoint* – Rom.5:5). He said, "This Jubilee will thus be a holy year marked with a hope that does not fade, our hope in God. May it help us to recover the confident trust that we require, in the Church and in the society, in our interpersonal relationships, in our international relations and in our task of promoting the dignity of all persons and respect for God's gift of creation". (Pope Francis, Spes Non Confundit 25).

**Jubilee indulgence:** Special graces for the forgiveness of temporal punishment due to sins are made available during the Jubilee year. Hence, the faithful may obtain a plenary indulgence, that is, the remission of all temporal punishments due to sin already forgiven, by meeting the normal conditions (confession, Holy Eucharist, prayer for Pope's intentions and having no attachment to sin).

Time frame for the Jubilee Year: From Christmas Eve of December 24,2024 to the Epiphany of the Lord of January 6, 2026 at Rome (by the Pope) and at the diocesan level from Holy Family Sunday of December 29, 2024 to the Holy Family Sunday of December 28, 2025.

How to participate in Jubilee 2025: Make a pilgrimage to any of the designated sites such as Most Holy Trinity

Church, Trinidad and participate in any of the scheduled programs for the Jubilee Year.
